What does the week look like at BLISS?

Monday to Friday mornings allow time for the students to dedicate time in the classroom, with experienced and qualified teachers, following our unique, specially developed BLISS syllabus, accredited by the British Council.

Our academic staff are committed to inspiring our students with a broad range of exciting lessons and activities. We ensure that students feel thoroughly engaged and ready to try something new.

Everyone attends classes based on age and level. We use the CEFR to help us grade students.

Our Director of Studies has been teaching English as a Foreign Language since 2001 and has run four different language schools across the UK and abroad. With a diploma in TESOL, and a BA (Hons) she is fully qualified to ensure that high-quality lessons are being delivered at all times.

Due to the nature of our syllabus, students are assured that across all levels they will study the same subjects on the same day, ensuring interactive opportunities outside, as well as inside, the classrooms.

Students also have an elective subject for ten hours per week. Every evening, there is a choice of leisure activities: sports, arts and crafts, team games, discos, cinema night, karaoke and many more besides. Every weekend, students have full-day excursions to local places of interest.

English learning at BLISS

Our course is based on the Theory of Natural Acquisition, pioneered by Stephen Krashen. We want the language to stick in the minds of our students and we want them to see learning the language as a pleasure. In this way, we have designed our course to have formal elements, as well as informal ones. When you learn your first language, you do so through listening, repetition and then understanding; this is Natural Acquisition. That is our aim for our learners.

While they might come to us not familiar with certain vocabulary, grammar or accent, they will certainly leave with a more familiar connection with English, as they will have full-immersion English when they are with us. Through working with the daily routine, following instruction and interacting with others, they will start to absorb and use language, which they didn't have before.

During the mornings, they will have their lessons in the classroom setting, where they will benefit from an interactive style of teaching and learning. They will work towards a weekly project at their own level and they will be able to ask their teacher and peers for support. We are accredited by the British Council.









Out of the classroom, they will be communicating in the common language with students from the UK as well as from many different nations. Staff only speak English and so, in order to be understood, they have to speak to us in English. So, whether they are in the common rooms, the onsite equestrian centre or in the sports halls, students have to communicate in English to ensure they can connect with others.

All the teachers follow the same syllabus, which means that all students are learning the same topics, but in different age groups and at different levels. In this way, all students can converse about their lessons in the morning, no matter what class they are in. Classes have a maximum of 16 students and have as diverse a range of nationalities as possible.

The process of learning is a holistic one, where the students are able to benefit from a completely safe learning and living environment. Here they can advance, hone, or perhaps start their journey with English.

English Language is at the centre of everything we do – it is fundamental to the program.

This course is also open to local UK students, so gives maximum opportunity for interaction and English communication.



Partnered with our local provider, over 3 days we do aqua zorbing, kayaking, archery and paddleboarding on the River Tay— each day is different, and exhilarating. On the other two days, we investigate the campus, explore bushcraft, survival skills and den making.







Horse Riding

BLISS at Kilgraston is the perfect place to enjoy summer horse riding. Horse riding is one of our most popular choices, due to the excellent facilities we have onsite. Horse riders will learn about stable and horse management and then we will get on our horse and do some practical work. No matter your level, we are happy to work with you to see you improve, give you suggestions to get on and see you get to the next level. We are fully experienced with riders of all levels, so if you want to, jump on and give it a go. Charlie and the rest of the horses are waiting!



The Art Department overlooks the grounds from the higher windows of the main school. 
Discovery Scotlan

Scotland is simply stunning. Any visitor who comes here will be captivated by the castles, the glens and the dramatic scenery all around. It is the land of the world's shortest commercial flight (47 seconds on a good day!), the home of golf and the Loch Ness Monster, of Sean Connery and Ewan McGregor, of scientists and politicians, artists and musicians, and of castles that were home to kings and queens of old.

BLISS at Kilgraston, Scotland, is situated just outside the historic town of Perth, often called the Gateway to the Highlands. Stirling is not far, where William Wallace fought and where the National Wallace Monument now dominates the skyline. This dramatic landmark can only be outdone by Stirling Castle itself, only a few kilometres away.

Weekend Trips

Every Saturday and Sunday we all go together on a coach to a city, town or other attraction that is of cultural interest to our students. We know that many of our students come back year after year, so we make these trips varied, different every weekend and every year.

We leave the school at 9.30am, with a packed lunch. We spend the full day out, led by our group leaders and activities staff and then we get back to school in time for dinner.

We also have a full schedule of evening activities at the weekend.



Catering, Campus and Accommodation

Catering

As the winner of many Healthy Eating awards, Kilgraston's Catering Team have a lot to be proud of! They will provide three meals a day, with hot and cold options, salad, soups and local cheeses and breads. They will also provide packed lunches for our full-day trips.

Dietary requirements are all looked after, as long as we know in advance. Menus can also be provided in advance.

Breakfast, lunch and dinner are all served in our dining room, and we have packed lunches at the weekends for our trips.

Campus

The campus is 72 acres of parkland, 4 miles south of Perth. It takes around 50 mins from Edinburgh airport and about one hour from Glasgow.

Onsite we have an equestrian centre, science lab, swimming pool, art department, many tennis courts and many other facilities to explore and discover

Accommodation

Boys and girls are accommodated in different areas and we will be using Mater and Butterstone House. The rooms are single, double as well as some dorms. The facilities are shared and on the floor next to the rooms.
